SDE College has 5,000 students per year and a staff of 900 employees, including teachers.

Fields of education

SDE College offers 45 different programmes under vocational education divided into 10 basic fields. We also offer upper secondary technical education in both Odense and Vejle. Furthermore, SDE College offers a wide range of standard courses, adult continued education/training and tailor-made courses for supplementary education/training of individuals, companies, and organizations.

SDE College is the result of a merger

SDE College was founded in 2008 as the result of a merger between Odense Technical College (Odense Tekniske Skole) and Vejle Technical College (Vejle Tekniske Skole). The historical roots of the two colleges date back as far as 1844 and 1855, respectively.

Today, SDE College covers a large part of the Region of Southern Denmark, and we have spread our activities so that we now operate from a total of ten locations in Jutland and on the island of Funen.

The Danish colleagues received us very friendly and after an impressive presentation about the Danish vocational system they showed us around the premises of SDE College.

The talks about common ground included the fields of media production / digital media, CNC specialists in metal working, electricians and specialists in electronics, automation and IT.

The next step will be a visit of the Danish colleagues to Hamburg, Germany and our Vocational Education and Training Center (VETC) for Technology and Media Farmsen G16 in spring 2014.
